

Intergroup to Intergroup
Sub-Committee Report
March 8-10, 2019

Purpose: The purpose of the intergroup to intergroup committee is to develop and implement actions to strengthen intergroup recovery.

The Intergroup to Intergroup committee met via conference call on November 18, 2018 and again on January 13, 2019 to continue working toward our goals. During the conference calls we discussed and decided upon revisions to the workshop materials. Jennifer L. from Louisville graciously offered to complete the revisions and update the workshop materials.

The committee also decided to present the next Intergroup Recovery Workshop in the Chicago area. Deanna was instrumental in contacting the intergroups in the Chicago area and selecting a date for the workshop. The next workshop will be held on April 13 at Elmhurst Hospital in Chicago. Central Ohio and Central Indiana have also expressed an interest in hosting the workshop in their areas.

Goals:

1. Identify and contact intergroups for pilot workshop. (Completed – Lansing area)
2. Develop daylong workshop aimed at strengthening intergroups. (completed)
3. Present workshop in Lansing area. (completed in October 2018)
4. Review and/or revise workshop format based on feedback from pilot workshop. (in progress)
5. Identify other intergroups/areas interested in the intergroup recovery workshop. (Chicago, central Ohio, central Indiana)

Next steps:

1. Review updated workshop materials – To be completed at the March 2019 Region Assembly.
2. Present workshop in Chicago – April 13, 2019
3. Determine location of workshops for the remainder of 2019 – To be discussed at the March 2019 Region Assembly. (Central Indiana is very interested in hosting the workshop in August or October if possible and central Ohio has also expressed interest)
4. Identify contact person each workshop location. – To be discussed at the March 2019 Region Assembly.
